The trick is to hopefully pick a peg or two where better fish are in residence. You can only catch what is in front of you. If they are small, it's harder to make a big weight. It will still be a good day if you catch 100 fish keeping busy all the time, even if you finish with 20lb rather than 30lb. We are talking natural venues, not Carp puddles. Me I would be more than happy with 20lb!! And not a carp in sight. Don't forget take a reed blade and trim your swim of lilies, may stop you loosing that big fish.
