
The Gt Ouse just waiting for National Anglers

Lots of work for the clubs involved all hoping the fish will join the party and make it a good match after all their efforts. 23 teams of ten all hoping for a good draw and more than a few fish.

Last Sundays Open on the Ouse was pretty hard going for many in the gin clear conditions, difficult to encourage the fish to stay and feed. Best pegs were above Modney Bridge where the event was won by Preston Innovations Matt Eason with 7 Kilo 500. Catches in this area made up of roach, perch and Tench. 5Kg 550 2nd.

Perhaps I jinxed it, when I said rain and flow should improve conditions Looking at the weather forecast and the news from the EDP, it suggested rain and storms over Norfolk, which didn't happen. Unfortunately, I was pitched up beside the Yorkshire Ouse at that time which was hammering through and on a Flood Alert.

However, with the Ely Ouse sections in the mix and lots of fish being observed in that area a good catch is always on.
