The Ouse still on good form for pleasure anglers with some great nets of roach. Best methods pole and whip feeding hemp and caster with either plus tares on the hook. Lots of fish and bites up in the water which suggests float the best.

This might account for the low weights in the feeder match. Unlike years ago the fish do not appear to like too much of a ground bait barrage on the Ouse, with more anglers on the bank than usual to all can influence the activities of the quarry.

Hopefully the forthcoming matches will be better. It's hard for the organisers after putting in so much effort when results are not so good, with 2.85K the best weight on the Ouse.
