Bailiffing Shepherds Port recently, I was regaled with news of regular catches of good bream on Kings, the best 17 fish in a session. Tempted by this info I had a couple of sessions catching a few decent Bream in noticeably good condition, but unfortunately not 17. More Bream being caught here in the last few days. Will keep anglers keen, for April 1st when the venue reopens.

Anglers on Springside searching for carp the best four in a session, to an angler last weekend Shepherds Lake for bream and carp and again a big chub or two.

The end of the season pretty-well blown away, and probably soon forgotten. Some better days recently but few anglers, on the bank.

Small fish prevalent along the Ouse unless you find a pocket or two of bigger roach and an occasional Rudd.

A Better Ouse catch.



Best catches above Modney. Better sport and better fish when the river is on the move. One angler reporting his best roach catch of the season on the Ouse on the last day with tip and feeder in hand, connected with a proper bream to, where have they gone? There are several historic bream hot spots on the water that are never fished. Although that is likely to be the answer. Once again, skimmers and few Bream, providing good sport around Littleport.

Anglers searching for bream on the Relief Channel were in the main unlucky finding shoals of roach instead, with a few Tench featuring to. The lucky ones or more skillful ones?? landing on the bream. Such a big water and a big wind but the Channel always known to throw up bream in the these conditions, particularly at Denver, with anglers struggling at Downham during the last week.

Predator anglers having some success on the Middle Level, with pike around Twenty pounds. Few bream and Tench rewarding anglers on tip and feeder.


Anglers are reminded that all Kings Lynn AA waters except Springside, are now closed The Lakes reopening on April 1 and rivers on June 16.
